1. Object

To recognise an individual by award of the title of Honorary Member in recognition of distinguished activity within the scope of ICNDT's objectives.

2. Eligibility

Individual member of National NDT society in membership of ICNDT who has given long-term (greater than 10 years) and distinguished support to the ICNDT in pursuance of its objectives.

3. Process

3.1 Chairman/Secretariat seeks written nominations from Executive Committee members one year prior to the first ICNDT meeting at each World Conference (Nomination Form attached).

3.2 Chairman and Immediate Past Chairman prepare a list of proposed nominees for consideration by IEC.

4. Voting

ICNDT full committee at first ICNDT meeting at each World Conference votes on the candidates. Approval requires positive vote by a minimum of half the voting members present.
