- What will the final format be? This is report of WG1, to be published on website not a formal recommendation from ICNDT.
- There was extensive discussion on individual issues. These were captured by the Chairman and will be incorporated into a final version.

Version 5 of this document had been circulated before the meeting, taking account of comments received. SKB summarised the comments received and actions taken.

VR suggested that the tolerances quoted for assessing results were not tight enough.

Following discussion, this proposal was challenged and the Chairman suggested collecting more data from examiners. This is the only point holding up this document.

8. Process for qualification and certification of personnel when 'introducing new NDT methods and techniques'

Note that the scope of ISO 9712:2012 covers "proficiency in one or more of the following methods:

- a) acoustic emission testing;
- b) eddy current testing;
- c) infrared thermographic testing;
- d) leak testing (hydraulic pressure tests excluded);
- e) magnetic testing;
- f) penetrant testing;
- g) radiographic testing;
- h) strain gauge testing;
- i) ultrasonic testing;
- j) visual testing (direct unaided visual tests and visual tests carried out during the application of another NDT method are excluded)."

But the scope also states that the Standard "can also apply to other NDT methods or to new techniques within an established NDT method, provided a comprehensive scheme of certification exists and the method or technique is covered by International, regional or national standards or the new NDT method or technique has been demonstrated to be effective to the satisfaction of the certification body."

Main points of the discussion were:

- Should we take into account only methods a to j? This would rule out phased array or TOFD (unless they could be considered under the general heading of "ultrasonic testing");
- The Chairman proposed to set up a process for compliance assessment of new NDT methods;
- These would need to be covered by standards;
- The method would need to be demonstrated to be effective to satisfaction of WG1:
- It was agreed that the action plan would need to be modified to accommodate this:
- It was noted that the application from Energodiagnostika for a PCB CA for the MMM method will need to be delayed until this is resolved;
- Do we have an audit capability (expert personnel) for new methods?

The Chairman invited proposals.

9. Revision of TR 25107 Guidelines for NDT training syllabuses

It was noted that a revision is in hand, with a draft imminent. Sharon Bond is the contact. PF suggested that the aim for training times will be to work by general topics, with details expressed as a percentage of the general topics.

10. IAEA developments on qualification and certification of NDT personnel

Patrick Brisset presented a report on the activities of ICNDT. He noted that TECDOC 628 was in process of revision and that guidelines for digital radiography were to be produced.

JMF summarised the situation:

- The October 2014 version has been produced. Following a delay in delivery, printed copies should be available on the ICNDT stand by Wednesday;
- Major changes were highlighted:
 - o Recommendations to certification bodies seeking cooperation
 - Encourage bodies operating outside home country to cooperate with national societies – signed agreement. ICNDT will mediate.
 - Guidance for developing countries
 - Recommendation to national standards bodies: urged to apply ISO 9712 fully.
 - o ICNDT MRA
 - ASME position: Change in section V allows use of ISO 9712 consistent with ICNDT advice. Hoped that applications sections of Code will dispense with own requirements. Reminder about employer's responsibilities.
 - o Appendix on certification schemes compliant with ISO 9712.
 - Appendix on MRA, PCB CA and EQB
 - o ISO 9712 implementation spreadsheet on web

12. Report on the work of the ICEC

Dr Shipp reported on the work of the ICEC. Key points were:

- MRA
 - Belgium (BANT) are being encouraged to sign Schedule 1 (Note: this was done by email shortly after this meeting)
 - Netherlands (SKO) are close to meeting requirement for Schedule 2 registration. The only remaining issue is confirmation that they are accredited to the 2012 issue of ISO 9712.
 - OP19 is in urgent need of revision (Note: this was emphasised by discussions at PGP/GA later in the week)
- PCB CA
 - o Audit arranged for ABENDI (Brazil) in November

 Audits required for ChSNDT (China), SAIW (South Africa) and a possible application from Malaysia. Details of the audits may depend on decisions made following revision of OP19.

EQB

- In process of providing EQB to Argentina free of charge in view of their work done on translation into Spanish
- SAIW have offered to provide additional questions. RS will draft a procedure for incorporating new questions.
