SUBJECT: RECOGNITION OF VOLUNTARY EFFORT IN NDT

ICNDT wishes to recognise the work of individuals and companies who provide voluntary effort in support of NDT. Both consistent effort over many years and major effort in support of a specific event are worthy of recognition.

Each member NDT Society may nominate up to four individuals, companies or organisations per year. (Individual Societies will be responsible for deciding on their nominations).

Each Chair of an ICNDT Committee or Working Group may nominate up to four individuals, companies or organisations per year.

Nominations should be sent to the Secretariat. The General Secretary prepares the letter based on information sent by the National Society (model letter in Annexe below).

Nominees will receive a letter signed by the Chairman congratulating them on their nomination and thanking them for their support. The letter will be sent to the National NDT Society/ Committee making the nomination, which will be responsible for its forwarding / presentation.
