SUBJECT: AWARDS

Scope

Applies to all ICNDT Awards, currently

| (iii) | Havercroft Award | for major contribution to NDT Education, Training or Certification |
| (iv) | Sokolov Award | for major contribution to NDT Research |
| (v) | ICNDT Young Achiever Award | for achievement of young people in NDT (<35 years) |

Eligibility

- Awards may be given to individuals, companies, societies, organisations or sub-divisions thereof who have made a significant contribution recognised internationally.
- Except for the Pawlowski Award, members of the ICNDT Executive and PGP Committees (and their organisations) shall be ineligible.

Process

- (i) ICNDT Secretariat seeks nominations from ICNDT Member Societies and members of the PGP via the ICNDT Website and e-mail one year prior to each World Conference
- (ii) A maximum of one nomination in each category per Member Society
- (iii) Nominations submitted by e-mail on the standard form (attached)
- (iv) Nominations received will be circulated to the PGP
- (v) PGP chooses one winner for each Award by secret postal ballot following discussions at the PGP prior to the one held at the World Conference
- (vi) Recipients to be advised at least 3 months before the World Conference (to facilitate attendance)

Form of the Award

The Award will consist of a framed Certificate carrying the logo of ICNDT, the name of the Award, the name of the recipient and the date.

Presentation

At the Opening Ceremony of the World Conference by the Chairman of ICNDT

Announcements

Award winners will be announced on the ICNDT Website.

Unsuccessful candidates will be advised by a letter from the Chairman of ICNDT.
